Postponement of the 29th National Scout Regatta

Earlier this month the Regatta Organising Committee recommended to the Board that the 29th National Scout Regatta (NR29) be postponed for 1 year. The Board considered this recommendation on the 22nd of May and made the decision to postpone all national events (Regatta, Venture & Jamboree) by one year.

The new dates for NR29 are now from the 29th of December 2021 to the 7th of January 2022.

We realise that the decision to postpone NR29 will be a disappointment to many youth, leaders and staff that had their hearts set on participating at the end of this year. However, the current Covid 19 pandemic has had a profound effect on almost all aspects of our lives and there is no doubt that the ability of many contingents to participate in NR29 would have been severely impacted had it been run on the originally planned dates.

The Regatta Organising Committee are aware that due to the postponement there are a number of youth, that would have been in the senior age group on the original dates, who are above the upper age limit with the postponed dates. The Regatta Organising Committee will be considering what options are available to ensure that these youth will still be able to participate in the postponed NR29 event.

We will call for expressions of interest for both contingents and staff again late 2020/early 2021. In the meantime, stay safe and we will see you all in December 2021.
