This is to confirm that the 29th National Scout Regatta (NR29), is an accredited and endorsed activity, managed through The Scout Association of New Zealand, and a local organising committee.

The National Scout Regatta is a large gathering of Scouts from all over New Zealand and other invited countries, generally in the Asia Pacific region. It will be held at Picton Harbour, in Marlborough from 28 December 2021 to 7th January 2022 and will provide activities offering young people the opportunity to develop personal skills, self assurance, teamwork and leadership skills under the guidance of adult leaders.

NR29 will be managed under the policy and rules of the Association in particular with respect to risk and safety management procedures, the duty of care to youth and adult Code of Conduct.

A very structured programme has been developed to lead the participants in fun filled adventurous challenging activities on and off site. Part of the overall shared experience means attendees will be camping under canvas and developing new friendships along the way.

We strongly support any application for funding towards this activity and ask that funding agencies look favourably upon any requests made to them. In addition to attendance costs, groups are required to fund their own transportation to the venue, insurance of equipment, troop uniform and incidental resource costs.
