#### Fees

We are still aiming to keep the fees as previously advised. These are still based on all the known budgetary items and suitable contingencies.

Attending Category	Price (NZD)
Youth Members:	\$500
Adult Leaders:	\$100
Adult Regatta Staff:	\$0 (free)

We have engaged with our contractors to confirm their original quotes and so far, they have come in at the same level although there are some indications that the food costs have gone up. The budget will require final sign off from the National Board when they meet in July after which we will advise the confirmed fees. Fees will be GST inclusive.

#### Age Groups

Age groups will be as previously advised.

Age Category	Age Range
Junior	10 – 13½ years
Intermediate	13½ – 15½ years
Senior	15½ – 18½ years*

\* Youth that turned 18½ after the commencement of Term 4 2021 will be permitted to enter as a senior

However, in recognition of the disruption of the original date, for those youth that would have been eligible to be seniors on the original NR29 date then they may also compete as a senior provided.

1. They were still registered in OSM at the commencement of Term 4 2020 and;
2. They are currently in some role in Scouts NZ (Rovers/Leader)

Note: Should the “senior” also be an adult leader or staff attending the regatta, to compete they will need to pay the youth member fee. ≈\$500

### **Cutters**

We are still awaiting final assessment of the suitability of the Fern Cutter for regatta and its comparability with the older GRP scout standard cutters. Once that is done a decision will be made for their inclusion and, if they are, the price they will be available for.

We are well underway with grant applications for the Feva's and it our intention to purchase 20 of these. These will be available for sale after NR29 for \$6000 (To Be Confirmed) to any interested groups.
